New feature [#12906](#) seems lacks a bit of implementation.

Example:

```
-> do
rescue
end
# => syntax error, unexpected keyword_rescue

lambda do
rescue
end
# => it's ok!
```

This behavior looks inconsistent.
I think all do/end blocks should work with ensure/rescue/else.
