<p>The method name "send" on UDPSocket https://ruby-doc.org/stdlib-2.5.0/libdoc/socket/rdoc/UDPSocket.html#method-i-send is confusing and inconsistent.</p> <p>The underlying libc method is called sendto(2) (or sendmsg()). The method "send" is confused with https://ruby-doc.org/core-2.5.0/Object.html#method-i-send</p> <p>I suggest:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. we rename it to sendto, leaving an alias.2. mark UDPSocket::send as obsoleted3. remove it in a future version <p>Some things like Celluloid::IO and the like will need encouragement to duck type the new interface sooner.</p>
