<b>Description</b> I have an alias called brewitup in my .zshrc that runs  brew update; brew upgrade; brew prune; brew cleanup; brew doctor  When I ran this it got hung up and gave me the error:  /usr/local/Homebrew/Library/Homebrew/cache_store.rb:31: [BUG] Segmentation fault at 0x00000001097ffffe  I have never put in a bug before so I tried to gather as much information as I could; I attached the command output and the crash report.
