The following gsub with a minus seems to work correctly:

```
ir>> "foo-bar".gsub("-", "\-")  
=> "foo\-bar"
```

But with a plus, it seems to run incorrectly by stripping the plus:

```
ir>> "foo+bar".gsub("+", "\+")  
=> "foobar"  
=end
```
