But information on bug reporting is and will always be available directly on the bugs.ruby-lang.org **main page**, or something has completely gone wrong. (Right now it links to both an English and a Japanese howto.)

That's where people should be directed to.

Also, bugs.ruby-lang.org is already referenced in several other places in the code.
